Cancer and the Law (also provided in Spanish)

In this seminar we discuss the most pertinent legal issues for people coping with cancer, including:

- **Health Insurance** options available to people with pre-existing medical conditions and coverage issues, including COBRA, state COBRA plans, the Health Insurance Premium Payment Program (HIPP), the Health Insurance Portability & Accountability Act (HIPAA), major risk plans, Medicaid, Medicare, other state and federal health care laws, and navigating managed care.
- **Employment** rights and protections under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), state fair employment laws, and the Family & Medical Leave Act (FMLA).
- **Government Benefits** available to people who are temporarily or permanently unable to work, including Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI), Supplemental Security Income (SSI), state disability insurance programs, and paid family leave for caregivers.
