Teleconferences & Webinars Topics

Employment: In this seminar, we provide an overview of employment rights in the workplace under the Americans with Disabilities Act, including asking for reasonable accommodations and disclosing your diagnosis at work and during the job application process.

Taking Time Off Work & Disability Insurance: In this seminar, we provide an overview of the federal and state laws that provide patients and caregivers with options for taking time off work and access to disability insurance benefits, such as the Family & Medical Leave Act, Social Security Disability Insurance, Supplemental Security Income, and paid leave options for caregivers.

Health Insurance: In this seminar, we will cover ways to get and keep health insurance coverage and health insurance options for individuals with pre-existing conditions.

Health Care Reform: This seminar will cover the changes to our health care system contained in the latest national health care reform efforts. Learn about new options available to children, young adults, and adults with pre-existing conditions and new protections related to rescissions, annual limits and lifetime caps on coverage, and access to clinical trials. In addition, we will cover new requirements for coverage of preventative care and Medicare benefits.

Maximizing Your Health Care Benefits: This seminar is being presented with MedClaims Liaison, and will provide tips and tricks on talking to insurance companies. The seminar will cover policy limitations, coding, the best questions to ask your insurance company, and more.

Navigating Insurance: This seminar will provide tips on how to navigate insurance coverage, including second medical opinions, clinical trials, and appealing insurance company decisions.

Genetics & the Law : This seminar provides an overview of genetics and the law, including issues such as how employers and insurance companies can use genetic information.

Estate Planning: The purpose of this seminar is to help people prepare for any potential situation by planning ahead to ensure that their loved ones and assets are protected. It will provide an overview of advanced health care directives, conservatorships, wills, trusts, and more.
